

LAMB CARCASS CONTEST

Superintendent: Larry Van Winkle

1. Wether and ewe lambs are eligible for competition.
2. Exhibitors may weigh in animals. Carcass designation is not required at this time.
3. All animals must be weighed and tagged at the appropriate weigh day: Lambs - May 6, 2008.
4. Each junior exhibitor is limited to ONE (1) lamb in the program.
5. Pre-entry is REQUIRED. The proper form must be completed and returned by entry day July 1, 2008.
6. The actual animal being entered in the carcass program must be designated at the fair weigh-in.
7. Required weights for carcass entry. All market lambs except Southdowns 100lbs. Southdowns and white face 85 lbs.
8. Carcass contest lambs will be shown in a separate class or classes to be determined by weights.
9. Animals entered in the contest will be delivered to Mountain Meats in Fruita by 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, July 23, 2008.
10. Carcass may be observed at Mountain Meats - (2:00 p.m., July 24th).
11. AWARDS:
 - Carcass 1st and 2nd place - cash awards
 - All Around Award - trophy plus 5 places.
 - Score based on:
 - Live placing
 - Daily Rate-of-Gain
 - Carcass Placing
 - Completed Record Book
12. Fees - \$10/Lamb
13. Exhibitors must secure their own buyers. (Buyers will be charged a \$40 processing fee).
