

LITTLE SQUEALERS SHOW (OPEN SHOW)

SPECIAL RULES:

The Little Squealers Program will be an OPEN SHOW. The animals will arrive Tuesday, July 22, 6:00 – 10:00 P.M., with the other swine projects and will be released with the other non-sale swine on Thursday, July 24th at 8:00 P.M. This class will show at 6:00 P.M. on July 24th or just prior to the Grand Champion selection.

- 1) Any youth 5-10 years old as of July 25, 2008 and has not shown a 4-H or FFA Swine project is eligible to enter.
- 2) Exhibitors must sign up by March 1, 2008 on the Little Squealers Entry Form at the Mesa County Extension Office. Limited to 10 individuals for this first year.
- 3) The animal will need to be tagged with an official Mesa County ear tag on May 8th or May 10th.
- 4) The animal must be born after January 1, 2008.
- 5) Any breed of swine as well as either sex is eligible for show.
- 6) Only one animal may be shown per exhibitor. Likewise only one exhibitor per animal. Exhibitors may use their older siblings animals.
- 7) The Little Squealers Class will be judged on showmanship only.
- 8) All dress code rules listed in the General Rule section will apply.
